
## A Challenge for Keen Photographers

## Ferriby Screen Goes Live!



To show we don't just throw our programme together, in May, Ferriby Screen presents a classic feature film tied in to our latest live performance.

**Friday 5<sup>th</sup> May**, we'll be screening *The Graduate (15)*, which launched the film career of Dustin Hoffman and won Mike Nicholls an Oscar for Best Director in 1968. It features award-winning performances from a young Katherine Ross and Anne Bancroft as Mrs Robinson, with whom the young graduate Benjamin Braddock embarks on an ill-fated affair. The film memorably features the music of Simon & Garfunkel and is a curtain-raiser to our presentation the following week.

**Friday (12<sup>th</sup> May)** we welcome the return of Tim Chu and Ian Bailey in *A Celebration of Simon & Garfunkel*, featuring music and anecdotes of one of the best-selling music groups of the 1960s. Their biggest hits including "The Sound of Silence" (1964), "Mrs. Robinson" (1968), "Bridge over Troubled Water" (1969), and "The Boxer" (1969), reached number one worldwide.

**Friday 7<sup>th</sup> April**, we present Peter Weir's 1998 film *The Truman Show (PG)*, often credited with predicting the phenomenon that was to become reality television. The film also gave the already-famous Jim Carrey credibility as a dramatic actor, earning him a Golden Globe.

**Easter Monday afternoon, 17<sup>th</sup> April**, we're showing the 1959 version of *Ben Hur (PG)*, the story of the Jewish prince who is betrayed and sent into slavery by a Roman friend, only to regain his freedom and come back for revenge. William Wyler's classic runs for more than three and a half hours, stars Charlton Heston, Jack Hawkins and Stephen Boyd, includes the famous chariot race and won eleven Oscars! Our bar will be open and you can partake of a special Easter afternoon tea! Doors open at 1.30 and the film begins at 2pm.

**Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> June** We will be showing Jane Austen's *Pride & Prejudice (U)*.

## Council Tax 2017/18

The Parish Council has set a budget of £73,000 for the coming financial year, 2017/18.

This is an increase on last year's budget, mainly to enable the Council to meet its obligations for its employees because of central Government legislation, particularly pension responsibilities.

A Band D property will now pay £42.98 per annum, an increase of £3.42 a year or 28.5p per month.


## Caretakers Wanted
